The District staff shall review the form and make a preliminary determination on whether the well meets the exemptions provided by District rules and respond to this request within 5 days. If the preliminary determination is that the well is exempt, drilling may begin immediately upon receiving the approved Notice of Intent to Drill. The drilling of a new well is at your own risk and subject to the rules of the District.

2. It shall be a violation of District rules for a well owner, well operator, or water well driller to drill any well without having first filed and received approval of the Preregistration Notice of Intent to Drill from the District.
