1. Call Public Hearing to order and establish a quorum

4. Water Level and Rainfall Report

- 6. Action, Discuss, or Consider Approval of Bills and Financial Statements for August 2024
 Operations Manager Lana Tolleson reviewed the revenue and expenditures for August 2024. Howorth made a motion to approve the August 2024 bills and financial statements. The motion was seconded by Campbell and passed unanimously.

The Directors reviewed the budget amendments necessary to cover the increased costs of coverage of TML IRP liability policies received after the FY 2024-2025 budget was approved. Taylor made a motion to approve the FY 2024-2025 budget amendments. The motion was seconded by Campbell and passed unanimously.

11. Action, Discuss or Consider Review of Responses to RFQ for General Counsel and Related Legal Services

Consulting Manager Meredith Allen reviewed the responses received to the RFQ for general counsel and related legal services. The deadline was Monday, September 9, 2024 at 4:00 p.m. After discussion, the Directors asked Allen to conduct interviews and bring back answers to their questions to the October 8th board meeting.

a. Training on new District Equipment – Allen informed the Board that we have received the new Hach 3900 Spectrophotometer that will be used when testing water samples. A representative from Hach helped set up the new equipment in our lab and gave Allen and Technician Sofia Galindo in-person training. The new borehole camera has also been delivered. Allen attended the Region F meeting in Big Spring on Thursday, September 5, 2024.
