- 4. The minutes of the May 5, 2022 meeting were reviewed. Ty Edwards made the motion to approve the minutes, Slate Williams seconded. The motion passed.
- 5. Diana Thomas made a motion to sponsor \$5,000 to the 4-H Water Ambassador Program. JJ Weatherby seconded, and the motion passed.
- 6. Robert Bradley with the Texas Water Development Board gave updates to the members.
 - Management Plan pre-review is highly encouraged for those District's that are needed to renew
 - The Hill Country BRACS report is ready and online
 - Larry French has retired, Natalie Bellew is the new director for the department
- 7. Meredith Allen gave updates to the members:
 - She asked if there were any questions or concerns with respect to joint planning and reviewed a tentative schedule for the next round of DFCs
 - She noted that the next cycle of DFCs were due May 1, 2026
- 8. Dr. Bill Hutchison presented his review of TWDB study: Improving Estimates of Groundwater Pumping in Aquifers of Central and Western Texas. He plotted comparisons of pumping the alternate GAM and the numbers from the TWDB study. After discussion, Dale Adams made a motion that we submit the review completed by Dr. Hutchison and submit a letter to the TWDB addressing concerns. Paul Tybor seconded, and the motion passed.
- 9. Dr. Bill Hutchison presented his review of TWDB study: Improving Estimates of Groundwater Recharge and Groundwater-Surface Water Interactions in Aquifers of Central and Western Texas. He noted that the TWDB

Study showed less pumping and more recharge than the alternate GAM. After discussion, Dale Adams made a motion that we submit the review completed by Dr. Hutchison and submit a letter to the TWDB addressing concerns. Paul Tybor seconded, and the motion passed.

- 10. Ty Edwards made a motion to approve the bills and financial statements. Vic Hilderbran seconded, and the motion passed.
- 11. No other matters were presented.
- 12. The next meeting was tentatively set for July 2023, pending the TWDB Study review response and any possible needs for joint planning.
- 13. Slate Williams made a motion to adjourn, Rhetta Yanez Hector seconded, and the motion carried.
